#### STATE OF THE CATTLE IDUSTRY

The USDA semi cattle industry reports a confirmed 61-year low in the cattle industry. This bares whether or not the cattle industry is or is not done shrinking, and could push cattle prices at all classes this year and beyond. Cattle and calves were at 89.3 million head which is the lowest in eight years.

Beef cow herds reported only 28.9 million nearing a record low. Kevin Good, vice president of industry relations and analyses with Cattlefax says that prices will continue to contract this year.




