
FARM BUREAU

PAINTING







The US Is Losing the Corn-Exporting Crown.



Over-easy, sunny-side-up, and melted into breakfast omelets... there's a new and popular way to get farm-fresh eggs delivered and enjoyed daily through Rent The Chicken. Rent The Chicken is a recently launched, progressive franchise offering the whole kit and caboodle for rent. The real deal includes a portable coop, at least two egg-laying hens, feed for the rental season, and phone and web chat support. Delivery is free within 50 miles of Greeley, Fort Collins, Boulder, and the northern suburbs of Denver. Sentinel-Jayce Capron


