1. Motion to accept the minutes from March made by Dana and seconded by Sam. Motion passes.
2. Treasure report by Dana: Deposit of \$1,655 in Bike-a-thon Donations were made. Withdrawals for CMAS snacks and water, new water cooler system for the teachers, lunch for the teachers from Sunflour Cafe, and gift cards for top boy and girl from each grade for bike-a-thon from Dairy Queen. The request is approved and Sam will send an email to Mrs. Castillo letting her know our decision and to keep in touch to set that up.

We have reached out to the sheriff's office for their help to block off the road for the bike-a-thon. We also need to make sure that we have all the materials that we need like new markers to mark the students' hands, extra helmets, etc. Sam will talk to Mrs. Cotton about possibly doing a bike safety class in P.E. class the week before. Sam and Dana are going to work on getting the parent letters and student waivers tomorrow, April 22nd, and get them sent home with students.
