

Sargent Elementary School – PTO Meeting

March 25, 2026

In attendance: Danielle Price, Tammi Plan, Emily Brown, Sam Smartt, Dana Barlow, Dana Brown

Meeting called to order at 2:33 pm by Sam Smartt.

1. Minutes from February: Sam moved, Tammi seconded to approve the February minutes. Motion passed.
2. Treasurer's Report: As of March 25, 2026, our balance was \$15,750.37. This included payments for the last two teacher appreciation meals, cash box withdrawal for book fair, CMAS snacks, and \$1,399.76 to Scholastic for the Book Fair. **Sam** will check with the bank again about refunding the fraudulent charge. **Dana** will deposit all the cash from book fair. (We were over \$4.57, from a few donations.) Sam moved, Tammi seconded to approve the Treasurer's Report.
3. Liaison/Teacher/Principal Update: The school moved the CMAS start date to Monday April 6th (from the 7th), mostly because State Science Fair is at the end of that week and this will help those kids not miss as much testing. The week of April 20th is Swimming for the younger classes. Frosty Acres is being brought to the school using some surprise Wellness Funds; this date will likely need to be rescheduled due to swim dates. Kindergarten Round-Up starts April 13th. Field trips are coming up (School Camp Out - Kindergarten, Cheyenne Mountain Zoo 1st, Cave of the Winds for 2nd, Night at the Museum for 3rd, 4th/5th don't know yet). They also want to have a swim day for students who showed improved in test scores. Smile for a Mile is May 19. Continuations will likely be on that last Wednesday (May 20th).
4. Old/New Business
 - a. Teacher Request Forms: none came in for this month, expect discussion around Smile for a Mile
 - i. Smile for a Mile: This year it will be a color run! PTO can pay for white shirts for all the students. We can use class lists from bike-a-thon, then just add on the couple new kids. Run will be around the campus. Older kids will go first, then will help youngest kids. He will likely use 6th grade too, especially to help throw colors, and might ask about NHS kids. Tuesday of the last day of school (May 19), starting at 2pm and going every 15 minutes. PTO will also get popsicles, water and Gatorade. Sam will be helping Flores find the colors. Dana will bring her big speaker. Parents could also bring water guns. The case fairs are already booked for the week before spring break, but they will let us know if anything opens up. Will be asking MeeMaw's Soda Truck too.
 - ii. Sam will buy some more drinks to reimburse for laminating sheets for bookmarks, and will be buying some more snacks for testing.
 - iii. Field Day – would be great to have water/popsicle station too
 - b. Teacher Lunch: Sam is picking up Subway on April 7th; with enough for two days of meals. Monday May 4th for Teacher Appreciation Week, ABC and PTO will jointly support coffee from Drift Away, between 7-9am. **Tammi** will look for Star Wars themed fun for May 4th, possibly cookies! Could also fill the fridge again with drinks

- c. Book Fair: Case fairs are already all booked for next spring, but they will keep us on the list if anyone cancels. Rachel laminated bookmarks, and **Dana Brown** will cut these all. Tammi dropped off all food to Alamosa Food Bank to go to La Puente. They were so thankful. We paid Scholastic \$1,399.76 for cash sales on book purchases. \$1,700 for deposit. Made almost \$2,000 in scholastic dollars, and spent around \$2,000. (Basically, we made around \$2,000.)
